

BY-LAW NO. 1796-04
CITY OF WINKLER

Being a By-law of the City of Winkler to provide for the regulation and control of the posting of signs and notices on public property in the City of Winkler.



WHEREAS Section 232 (1) (b) of the Municipal Act provides in part for the passing of by-laws for municipal purposes respecting activities and things in, on or near a public place or a place open to the public, including municipal roads, parks, recreation centres and facilities.

AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary and expedient to prohibit and regulate certain signs in the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Winkler enacts as follows:

1. That no person or persons shall post or cause to be posted up any signs or notices or to erect any sign or billboard on any street, boulevard, ditch or other public property and or on any traffic or street sign post whether in ditches or boulevards or on any public building, public structure or fence in the City of Winkler with exceptions as follows:
 - i) garage sale signs and notices posted on the garage sale billboard located on the City Recreation grounds.
 - ii) traffic signs, street signs and directional signs as authorized by Council for the regulating and control of traffic on public streets and lanes.
 - iii) signs posted by the City of Winkler for purposes of public notice required under the Municipal Act and Planning Act.
 - iv) signs posted under the Municipal Election Act or as provided for under Provincial and Federal Acts and/or jurisdiction.
2. That the Police Chief or his designate is hereby authorized to approve the posting or display of temporary signs and notices on boulevards or other public property for special public occasions. Any such requests shall be made on the appropriate application form provided by the City of Winkler.
3. That any person(s) in violation of this by-law shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00 plus costs, or a period of not more than thirty (30) days imprisonment, or both such fine and imprisonment unless otherwise provided for under an Act of the Province of Manitoba.
4. That By-law No. 1217-83 is hereby repealed.
